The six instruments play through close microphones routed into a mixing desk, where their amplification is gated by telegraph keys, one for each instrument/channel. The keys are inserted at the channel insert and they cut the sound of the channels when pressed. For larger halls the amplification could first be passed through a main mixing desk first before subrouted to the mixing desk on stage where the telegraph keys are connected. This is to boost and mix the level of the instruments.

The keyboard should have a separate full range amp on stage so that the instrumental sound can blend there. The electronic drone could be played through CD or any other source from the stage mixing desk, and mixed to the PA, in general this could stay at a soft level through the entirety of the piece.

The instruments in general play two types of sounds, one is a pitch based sound with occasional slow glissandos, the other is a noise based sound which can be achieved through air (wind instruments) or bowing on the bridge (strings). In the case of the synth, there should be 2 presets on the instruments which the player can switch from a triangle wave based sound and a noise based sound, with soft filtering for the latter that is key position sensitive, so that the higher the written pitch, the higher the band pass filter is used.

Breathing for the wind instruments can be staggered through the phrase, with an awareness of not breathing when a telegraph key is tapping a sound from that instrument. Circular breathing can be used if possible.


